

She is done with her mashed vegetables, but loves to eat bread. Her hair gets curlier every day. She plays a lot with Dulce who is just 4 months older. Overall she is just a happy baby and we love having her with us!



Tatiana, our eldest at almost 4 years old, has been with us a year. She NEVER, NEVER, stops talking. She can talk all day about her family, the children in our home, about the house rules and what not to do (and then still does it) or what to do (and, of course, does not do

it). Her favorite topic is her new shoes (only 2 months old, but already full of holes). She loves to dance, listen to music, and eat mangos. She is a bit



quirky! She repeats the same things over and over, has no concentration, and totally does not understand the consequences of bad behavior. Playing together with the younger children is not going well. Sharing toys is not going to happen. However, she giggles a lot and loves to be tickled. Mi Casita would not be the same without her!





Dulce arrived at Mi Casita in December 2016. She was 9 months old and didn't even weigh 12 pounds. She had to have special formula, and since her birthday in March, she is also eating table foods. And yes she's growing, but gaining weight very, very slowly. She has had court ordered tests for which Mi Casita paid. She seems completely healthy with the exception of her weight. She's a happy little girl and often has a big

grin on her face with lots of giggling. Every time she sees somebody coming in or going out, she starts waving. She crawls around all the time, and with help, is starting to walk. And because

of her high voice, we hear her babbling almost all day. She adds joy to our family!





Yulisa arrived at Mi Casita 2 months ago when she was not yet 2 months old. Her story is very sad. Her mom is only 14 years old. She and her mother were initially in another home, but the home could

not take care of Yulisa anymore. She came to us very dirty, and weighing not even 7 pounds. Luckily, she has already gained 3.5 pounds because of the special formula we're feeding her. She is a very quiet baby, who lately is starting to smile more and more. The court has ordered many tests for which we must pay. These tests require that we transport her to the hospital in Guatemala City for which we also must pay. As a

result, we go to the City once a week and spend a whole day in the hospital. We still have no medical reports pertaining to her condition. Regardless, we are happy to provide her with a loving home!
